My Expectations for you:

1. Be Prepared.
2. Be Respectable.
3. Be Responsible.

Classroom Procedures you NEED to know:

A. Keep an accurate notebook for this class.

You are required to have a 3-ring or spiral notebook for this class. You will keep notes, handouts, and any other required items in the notebook. This notebook will be graded each chapter based on its completeness and organization.

B. No cell phones, no smartwatches, and no headphones/earbuds.

ALL electronic devices need to be off your body, off your desk, and in your backpack/bag. If you violate this policy, the item will be placed in the pocketed holder by my desk. You may receive a detention. You may not use your cell phone as a calculator.

C. No fidget devices.

D. Use of restroom and locker.

Use the bathroom or going to your locker is acceptable after instruction is over. If you abuse the open policy I have, you may have restrictions placed upon you. You will let me know you are leaving and take the pass with you. **Only one person may leave at a time.**

E. All tests and quizzes will be announced.

You will know about every assessment opportunity ahead of time. We will often review in class in order to make sure you understand what material is going to be assessed. You are responsible for preparing for that assessment outside of class.

Quizzes are open note. On tests, you will be allowed to use one 3" by 5" note card. It must be turned in with the test. All information on the note card will be hand written.

You will be allowed to correct tests in order to earn half the point missed back. For example, if you score a 74% on a test, then, if you correctly fix each error and show work, then you can earn 13% back. This raises your score to an 87%. All test correction will occur during Viking Time, your study hall period, before school, or after school on announced dates. All corrections must be completed in one session.

F. Academic Dishonesty will not be tolerated. If caught cheating, a zero will be entered for the grade. The zero is permanent. No alternate opportunity will be provided.

G. If you are absent, you are responsible for asking for what you missed. You will find much of what you need in CANVAS under MODULES. You will have two school days for each day absent to make up work. If you are going to miss for a school event, you may get the assignment ahead of time or the following school day. You will have two days to complete the assignment.

If you receive ISS/OSS, your assignments will be in CANVAS under MODULES. For ISS, they are due the next day. If you receive OSS, we will discuss due dates.

If you are quarantined, then you are responsible for staying caught up. See CANVAS under MODULES

H. Follow all rules as designated in the school handbook.

Grading:

Grades will consist of homework, notebook, quizzes, tests, and/or projects. You will be graded on using total points. The Semester Test is 10% of the final semester grade.

The school grading scale will be used.
