This may include but is not limited to: student activity, unplanned event, illness/medical, ISS, OSS, unexcused, bereavement, etc...

A MINIMUM of two school days will be allowed to make up work for each day missed. If make-up work is not completed, students will receive no credit. The student is responsible for understanding the deadline expectation. The student has the responsibility to contact teachers initially, regarding make-up assignments. If the parents or students have concerns, they are encouraged to contact the teacher.

The student will find the lesson plans plus any important material in CANVAS under MODULES. It is the student's responsibility to access the information and complete any assignment.

- ◇ Access CANVAS for lesson plans and/or assignments.
- ◇ Access on-line resources for support video lessons.
- ◇ E-mail questions to me by end of school day.
- ◇ All assignments are due upon return to class.

Late Work Policy

Late work is defined as any work that was not turned in by the specified deadline.

**When is work considered as
late?**

It is your responsibility to turn in work by the specified time. This is usually the next class session at the start of class. After that time, it is late.

**What are the consequences for
late work?**

You have 1 extra day to complete the assignment for full credit. If the assignment is turned in after that time, then the maximum grade would be 70%.

All assignments for a chapter must be completed
before the test.

Zeroes as Grades

Is it possible for students to earn a zero? Explain.

You will earn a zero when you choose not to complete the assigned task or for academic dishonesty. Academic dishonesty includes copying another person's work, using a problem solving app, using AI, and creating test reference cards/sheets that violate the rules expressed in the classroom expectations.

When are the zeroes recorded?	Due date or ASAP.
Are zeroes permanent?	Zero grades earned due to cheating are permanent zeroes. If an assignment is late, then it may be turned in for credit. See "Late paper Policy."

Re-dos and Corrections: *Can the following be fixed/redone?*

	YES/NO	Explain
Daily Work	NO	Daily check for understanding.
Quizzes	NO	Open note.
Tests	YES	May earn half points back for correcting errors and showing work.
Projects	NO	Extended work time to complete with class time provided.

Special Policies for failing students

The failing student may turn in late work for the **Current Chapter** only. The maximum possible grade will be determined when it is turned in (see late paper policy). If the student has not corrected the last previous test, they may also correct it for half points back.

If a student speaks with me, we can develop a plan to help them raise the grade to passing. I believe it is my responsibility to help my students be successful but they must meet me half way.

Extra Credit

Is extra credit available in your classroom?	Bonus problems may appear on tests to challenge students.
How often?	Chapter tests (but not all of the tests will have bonus).
Max Amount?	The bonus problem will have an indicated point value.
